Ancient Rome Workshop at London Road

Tuesday 15th March

Dear Parents/carers,

On **Tuesday 15th March**, Year 3 will take part in an exciting workshop about Ancient Rome. This will be delivered to us by the company 'One Day Creative'. This workshop will support the children to learn facts about life in Ancient Rome and understand through drama how people lived at that time and how the Romans affected Britain.

This workshop will take place on our **London Road site** in our fabulous drama studio. Year 3 will spend the day at the London Road site and carry out their usual lessons linked to this topic in the classrooms at London Road. We would therefore kindly ask you to drop and collect your child from the London Road site that day.

Please bring your child to the KS2 playground at London Road at 9.00am. Your child's class teacher will be waiting on the playground for them.

If your child attends breakfast club then please take them to Hackbridge Corner as normal that morning before 8am. School staff will walk them to the London Road site.

They will need to bring their usual book bag, water bottle and school contact book. If your child is a packed lunch they will need to bring their packed lunch. If your child is a school dinner, then a school dinner will be provided for them that day by Caterlink.

Please collect your child from London Road at 3.30pm from the KS2 playground. You child's class teacher will be waiting with them.

If your child attends after school club then a school or Jancett member of staff will walk them to Hackbridge Corner site and you can collect them from there as normal. If your child attends Futsal then a school adult will walk them to Hackbridge Corner and you can collect them from there as normal.

This will be an exciting opportunity for the children to learn more about Ancient Rome and a chance to explore the London Road site in preparation for next year. We can assure you that all of our usual covid measures are in the place and a thorough risk assessment has been carried out and shared with London Road staff and the workshop facilitator.
