As part of our computing curriculum, we are celebrating Safer Internet Day on the 8th February this year. Safer Internet Day is celebrated across the globe in over 170 countries, with thousands of young people joining in across the UK to explore how they can use the internet responsibly, respectfully, and creatively whilst making the most of their relationships online.

The theme for this year's Safer Internet Day is 'All Fun and Games? Exploring respect and relationships online.' From gaming and chat, to streaming and video, young people are shaping the interactive entertainment spaces they are a part of. We will be using Safer Internet Day to celebrate young people's role in creating a safer internet, whether that's whilst gaming and creating content, or interacting with their friends and peers and having discussions about how they can create positive change online.
