## Dinosaur Planet



### TOPIC OVERVIEW

Stomp, crash, roar! Watch out – there are dinosaurs about! Yes, that's right, we're travelling back in time to the age of the dinosaurs.

This half term, we'll visit a museum, look closely at ancient fossils and study reptiles to understand how dinosaurs may have lived and eventually died out. We'll learn about the palaeontologists and study dinosaur teeth and bones to find out what dinosaurs liked to eat. Learning dinosaur names, creating puzzling riddles and writing fantastic fact files are some of the other activities we'll be involved in this half term. We'll also use our artistic skills to sketch dinosaurs and create fossils using a variety of media.

At the end of our project, we'll invite you to our dinosaur museum where we will share our knowledge with you.

### ENGAGE EVENT

We will make dinosaur fossils and dinosaur skeletons. We will go on a fact finding scavenger hunt using the iPads. We will create dinosaur eggs and have a visit from a dinosaur!

### EXPRESS EVENT

We will present our dinosaur learning to you by creating our own dinosaur museum.

**WHAT WE WILL COVER AS PART OF THE ILP THIS HALF-TERM:**

<b>ILP Main Focus</b>	<b>History and Science</b>
<b>English</b>	We will read a variety of non-fiction books to find out information about dinosaurs. We will create our own dinosaur riddles and non-chronological reports.
<b>Science</b>	We will learn how to identify and names a variety of common animals that are carnivores, herbivores and omnivores. We will continue to describes and compares the structure of a variety of common animals (fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals, including pets). We will find out about the different features of a dinosaur and their habitats.
<b>Art and design</b>	Using our sketch books, we will sketch and shade a dinosaur.
<b>Design and technology (DT)</b>	We will use different media such as clay and other materials to create our own dinosaur fossils.
<b>History</b>	We will use photos and secondary sources to explore the past beyond living memory. We will learn what the world was like when dinosaurs lived and how dinosaurs died.

**SUBJECTS THAT WE WILL TEACH IN ISOLATION THIS HALF-TERM:**

<b>Mathematics</b>	We will learn how to count in 2s, 5s and 10s. We will continue to practise adding and subtracting numbers. We will compare and measure objects using objects and rulers. We will record our estimates and measurements.
<b>Geography</b>	We will continue to look at seasons including the differences between them and when each season falls.
<b>Computing</b>	We will learn how we can use the computer beyond school and use the internet to find out facts about dinosaurs. We will complete our online safety tasks.
<b>Music</b>	We will continue to follow the Charanga programme.
<b>Physical education (PE)</b>	We will learn basic skills like running and how to control and move with a ball in different ways.
<b>Religious education (RE)</b>	
<b>Personal, social, health and economic (PSHE) education</b>	We will learn how to share ideas and take turns. We will begin to evaluate our own learning and talk about what we have done well and what we could do to make it better.
