Our Imaginative Learning Project (ILP) for this half-term is...

Superheroes



TOPIC OVERVIEW

Let's put on our capes and discover our superpowers as we search for an answer to the question, 'What is a superhero?'

This half term, we'll describe our favourite superheroes, read a range of comic books and write our own story. Learning about real-life heroes such as the Police and Fire brigade will allow us to appreciate human bravery. We will consider how we can be real life superheroes by visiting the Ecology Centre. As part of this project, we'll explore different materials and investigate which material would be best for a cape.

We'll have plenty to share at the end of our project. We'll design colourful posters to show how 'superkids' can help the earth and be an Eco Warrior!

ENGAGE EVENT

We will be visited by some real life superheroes and learn how they help others. We will visit the Ecology Centre where we will find out about the importance of recycling and how we can help the planet.

EXPRESS EVENT

We will share our Ecology trip photos and posters with you. We will also share our 'Little Red Hen' stories via a presentation.

WHAT WE WILL COVER AS PART OF THE ILP THIS HALF-TERM:

ILP Main Focus	Science and PSHE
English	We will read the 'Little Red Hen' story. We will use 'talk for writing actions' to retell the story and then write it. We will take on the role of superheroes and act out superhero actions to learn about verbs.
Science	We will learn about natural and man-made materials. We carry out an investigation to discover which material is waterproof for a superhero cape. We will record our findings.
Art and design	We will use different materials to decorate our superhero masks.
Design and technology (DT)	We design and make our own superhero masks. We will write about the different materials and equipment we need and evaluate our masks.
Geography	We will answer simple questions such as, 'what is the busiest time at the park?' We will learn and describe how pollution (e.g. litter) affects the local environment by taking a trip to the Ecology Centre.
Physical education (PE)	We will learn and copy different movements and create our own superhero dance.
Personal, social, health and economic (PSHE) education	We will discuss the difference between right and wrong and learn how to be a real life superhero. We will continue to evaluate our own learning and talk about what we have done well and what we could do to make it better.

SUBJECTS THAT WE WILL TEACH IN ISOLATION THIS HALF-TERM:

Mathematics	We will continue to represent a number to 50 using dienes. We will learn how to add and subtract 10 from a number. We will add and subtract a 1-digit number to a 2-digit number to 20. We will compare, measure and record height.
Computing	We will learn about algorithms and programme Bee Bots. We will complete our monthly online safety tasks.
Music	We will continue to follow the Charanga programme.
