Muck, Mess and Mixtures



TOPIC OVERVIEW

We're warning you; this is going to get messy!

This half term, we'll have a messy morning to investigate mixtures and a variety of art techniques such as marbling. We will also explore different colours and what happens when we mix them together! We'll enjoy the story of George's Marvellous Medicine and write recipes, leaflets, lists and stories of our own. We will make our own Marvellous Medicine in class and design and a medicine bottle. We'll use our science skills to explore everyday materials. We'll learn how to measure using scales, measuring jugs and cylinders accurately. Our artwork will also rely on our mixing skills. We'll use marbling inks to make unusual patterns and create food landscapes inspired by Carl Warner. We will also be considering foods which are healthy and not so healthy and creating some pop-up cards using a variety of materials and techniques.

At the end of our project, we'll turn our classroom into a gallery and invite you to view our exhibition. We'll arrange images from the project into a PowerPoint presentation.
