Our Imaginative Learning Project (ILP) for this half-term is...



Street Detectives



Grab a magnifying glass, put on your deerstalker and change your name to Sherlock because we're going to become street detectives!

This half term, we'll follow a route around our local streets and take pictures of the buildings, businesses and plants we can see. Reading information about the area will help us understand how the local community could be improved. We'll write poetry, an information text and create persuasive adverts. Looking at photographs will help us to spot any similarities and differences between the houses and shops of today and the past. We'll find out about the history of our school and how it has changed. We'll also study and draw maps, create a clay model of a building, look at the work of urban artists and do some mono printing.

At the end of our project, we'll design posters to advertise a 'big spring clean' around school before cleaning and tidying the school grounds.

ENGAGE EVENT

We will go on a walk around our local area and look at the human and physical geography features around us.

WHAT WE WILL COVER AS PART OF THE ILP THIS HALF-TERM:

ILP Main Focus	Geography
English	Information text, poetry, persuasive writing
Science	Electricity and circuits
Art and design	Clay modelling and mono printing
Computing	Turtle logo and Scratch
Design and technology (DT)	Sewing skills
Geography	Human and Physical Geography, changes over time and comparing differences.
History	Changes to local areas
PE	Ball skills and beginning competitive sports.
PSHE	Knowing when and where to find help if needed.

SUBJECTS THAT WE WILL TEACH IN ISOLATION THIS HALF-TERM:

Mathematics	Exchanging 2 digit numbers using addition and subtraction.
Music	Explore different uses of musical instruments and voice.
Religious education (RE)	Name the special books of Christianity, Judaism and Islam.

Your child will have two home learning grids for this half-term: one for the Imaginative Learning Project and one for Mathematics. They should aim to complete a minimum of 3 activities on each grid by the end of the half-term.
