Our Imaginative Learning Project (ILP) for this half-term is...



Wriggle and Crawl



Put on your coat and wellies and let's head outside on a minibeast hunt.

This term, we'll head to the community garden next to our school to identify minibeasts in their natural habitat. We'll write a set of instructions for other children to use on a minibeast hunt, create minibeast stories and riddles. When we are in the garden, we'll explore trees and bushes to see what lives there, investigate how far and how fast a snail can travel. In school we observe the life cycle of a butterfly from caterpillar to adult butterfly. We'll sketch detailed drawings of minibeasts, make mobile minibeast models from a variety of materials and use magnifying glasses to observe minibeasts up close. Our ICT skills will help us create a minibeast animation and design our minibeast models.

ENGAGE EVENT

We will visit the community garden next to our school for a minibeast investigation.

EXPRESS EVENT

We will celebrate the children's work by making a slideshow of some of our work and minibeast models.

WHAT WE WILL COVER AS PART OF THE ILP THIS HALF-TERM:

ILP Main Focus	Science
English	Instructions, stories and riddles.
Science	Animals including humans, all living things.
Art and design	Minibeast sketches
Computing	Manipulating digital content in Microsoft Word and designing animations using scratch.
Design and technology (DT)	Designing and making mobile toys using appropriate materials and using wheels and axles.
Geography	Exploring and analysing simple patterns.
PE	Dance
PSHE	Money and setting personal goals.

SUBJECTS THAT WE WILL TEACH IN ISOLATION THIS HALF-TERM:

Mathematics	Recapping all areas.
Music	Explore different uses of musical instruments and voice.
Religious education (RE)	Explore religious stories.

Your child will have two home learning grids for this half-term: one for the Imaginative Learning Project and one for Mathematics. They should aim to complete a minimum of 3 activities on each grid by the end of the half-term.
