## Scrumdiddlyumptious!



### TOPIC OVERVIEW

We're going to embark on a scrumptious food journey, discovering where food comes from, healthy eating and food packaging. We'll learn about foods from around the world focusing on fair trade. In art and design, we'll make observational sketches of the inside and outside of fruit and vegetables. In ICT we will look at how we can use a computing software to create a sweet wrapper, following research on packaging. We will research where chocolate comes from and the chocolate making process. Our class reading books we will be 'Charlie and the Chocolate factory' by Roald Dahl, whilst our writing focus will be based on the book 'The Great Chocoplot' by Chris Callaghan. Our science topic will enable us to learn about different food groups, healthy eating and effects of nutrition on our bodies.

### ENGAGE EVENT

We will create and design our own chocolate packaging, sweet making machine and test our knowledge on where our food comes from.

### EXPRESS EVENT

Join our art gallery of scrumptious food sketches and sweet machines.

### WHAT WE WILL COVER AS PART OF THE ILP THIS HALF-TERM:

ILP Main Focus	<i>Science - nutrition</i>
English	We will write a narrative based on the story 'The Great Chocoplot' by Chris Callaghan. We will write a non-chronological report about skeletons. We will learn a poem from 'Charlie and the Chocolate factory'.

<b>Science</b>	Our topics will look at animals, including humans – exploring, nutrition, skeletons and muscles, as well as animal habitats.
<b>Art and design</b>	Using our art books to sketch fruits and vegetables, as well as creating Remembrance Day art.
<b>Computing</b>	Drawing and desktop publishing and online safety.
<b>Design and technology (DT)</b>	We will create and design our own chocolate packaging and sweet making machine using a range of modelling materials.
<b>Geography</b>	Exploring foods from around the world.

**SUBJECTS THAT WE WILL TEACH IN ISOLATION THIS HALF-TERM:**

<b>Mathematics</b>	We will be using the column method to add and subtract numbers up to 3 digits. We will then move onto column multiplication and dividing numbers by 3, 4 and 8.
<b>History</b>	We will look at the history of chocolate through literacy, as well as appreciate the importance of Remembrance Day through poppy art.
<b>Music</b>	Listing, appraising and performing through the music scheme Charanga.
<b>Physical education (PE)</b>	Real PE and Gymnastics.
<b>Religious education (RE)</b>	Our topic will focus on ‘Has Christmas lost it’s true meaning?’
<b>Personal, social, health and economic (PSHE) education</b>	A range of topics including; human life cycle, self-respect, identifying, communicating emotions, personal responsibility, managing risks and hazards.
<b>MFL – French (KS2 only)</b>	We will learn the French words for different parts of the face and body and words for our family.

Your child will have two home learning grids for this half-term: one for the Imaginative Learning Project and one for Mathematics. They should aim to complete a minimum of 3 activities on each grid by the end of the half-term on Google Classroom.

At Hackbridge Primary School our school curriculum follows the framework for the national curriculum, supported by the use of Cornerstones materials alongside other learning and experiences, to offer a curriculum which is balanced and broadly based.

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
