## Tribal Tales



Let's travel back to prehistoric times!

Through our research, we'll learn about the Stone Age, the Bronze Age and the Iron Age. What were people's daily lives like and what epic battles did they fight? We'll look closely at cave paintings and create our own. We will examine Stone Aged 'poo' to find out what they used to eat. We will explore and compare life through the different Ages and present our work in a double page spread.

### ENGAGE EVENT

We will look closely at cave paintings and use chalks and pastels to create our own cave painting. We will examine Stone Aged 'poo' to discover what they used to eat. We will use mixed media to create a picture of a woolly mammoth.

### EXPRESS EVENT

Parents will be sent a presentation to view the children's fabulous work they have produced throughout the half term.

## WHAT WE WILL COVER AS PART OF THE ILP THIS HALF-TERM:

<b>ILP Main Focus</b>	<i>History – ancient Greeks</i>
<b>English</b>	We will read the story of Stone Aged Boy and write a postcard home from the past. We will write instructions on how to wash a woolly mammoth.
<b>Art and design</b>	We will explore chalk cave art and create our own cave drawing.
<b>History</b>	We will explore how Britain changed across the Stone Age, Bronze Age and Iron Age.

## SUBJECTS THAT WE WILL TEACH IN ISOLATION THIS HALF-TERM:

<b>Mathematics</b>	We will learn about measurement in m, cm and mm. Within this strand we will use strategies we have learnt in addition and subtraction to add and subtract lengths and calculate perimeter. We will explore fractions including halves, quarters, thirds and tenths. We will learn how to count in tenths and find equivalent fractions.
<b>Computing</b>	We will learn how to create a PowerPoint presentation.
<b>French</b>	We will learn about Mardi Gras and the French words for the days of the week. We will learn the French words for Easter.
<b>Geography</b>	We will learn about vegetation belts and biomes.
<b>Music</b>	Charanga
<b>Physical education (PE)</b>	Real PE ball skills.
<b>Science</b>	We will continue our study of plants learning about the structure of flowers, how some plants are pollinated and fertilised and the different ways that seeds are dispersed. We will look at the life cycle of a plant.
<b>Religious education (RE)</b>	Our topic will look at Christianity. We will be learning about the Bible and some stories and we will also look at the Easter story.
<b>Personal, social, health and economic (PSHE) education</b>	Our focus will be right and wrong, fair and unfair, and kindness.

Your child will have two home learning grids for this half-term: one for the Imaginative Learning Project and one for Mathematics. They should aim to complete a minimum of 3 activities on each grid by the end of the half-term.
