### TOPIC OVERVIEW

Open wide – let's look inside! We're on a voyage of discovery to investigate the busy world inside your body.

This half term, we'll find out all about our teeth and learn new scientific vocabulary. We'll use this information to learn about what teeth are used for and the best ways to keep them clean and hygienic. There will be lots of investigating as we learn about our different teeth, how to brush them and how sugary drinks affect them. We'll creatively learn about the journey a piece of food takes through the digestive system. In science, we'll learn about the organs involved in digestion and make our own wearable digestive systems in D&T.

At the end of the ILP, we'll write a narrative using the book 'Demon Dentist' by David Walliams. We'll also write an explanation text about the digestive system using everything we have learnt.

### ENGAGE EVENT

Science day where children can dress up as a medical professional and take part in some fun experiments.

### EXPRESS EVENT

Parents will be sent a presentation to view the children's fabulous work they have produced throughout the half term.
