### TOPIC OVERVIEW

Ssh... What's that noise? Is it a bash, a crash, a shake or a hum?

This half term we will explore the science of sound and sample noises to create music in a creative and imaginative way. Monkey Symphony will inspire us to write stories from different perspectives, carry out interviews by hot seating characters and writing a critic's review. We'll investigate the volume of sounds and make vibrations using different equipment. Our toes will be tapping along to all kinds of music, and we'll be listening to song lyrics to analyse and understand the meaning of music from around the world. We'll create artwork using stencils and geometric patterns. We'll find out how our ear works, how sound travels and learn about pitch. We'll share our favourite music and explore how music is used in everyday life.

### ENGAGE EVENT

The children will be immersed into the topic with a day filled with music and sounds.

### EXPRESS EVENT

Parents will be sent a presentation to view the children's fabulous work they have produced throughout the half term.

### WHAT WE WILL COVER AS PART OF THE ILP THIS HALF-TERM:

Art and design	Creating pieces of art using stencils and geometric patterns.
