TOPIC OVERVIEW

Let's travel back in time to meet the terrifying Tudors.

During this half term, we'll meet a very important figure from history who will give us a problem to solve. Online research will help us to write biographies about influential people of the period, and we'll use source materials to create a Tudor timeline. Tudor portraits will provide us with the inspiration to create royal paintings; we'll learn a courtly dance and compose Tudor music. Our geography skills will help us to compare maps of Tudor London to present day London and plot Anne Boleyn's journey to her execution. Internet research will help us learn more about Henry's life, his marriages and his break from the Roman Catholic church.

At the end of the ILP, we'll create and perform a rhyme to help us remember key dates from the Tudor period. It will be huge! In PE, we'll learn some dance moves and hold a Tudor Dance. Maybe some of the Tudor royal family will be present!

WHAT WE WILL COVER AS PART OF THE ILP THIS HALF-TERM:

ILP Main Focus	History
English	Biographies, recounts and persuasive letters.
Art and design	Drawing Tudor portraits using an observed style, drawing from different angles and commenting on the emotional effects of art work.
Design and technology (DT)	Researching textile artists of the Tudor period and commenting on their work, combining ingredients to make food traditional of the time and evaluating its links to the Tudor Period.

Geography	Naming and locating counties of the United Kingdom in relation to their importance during the Lancashire and Wessex merge.
History	Making connections between two periods of history, learning to us appropriate terms to discuss moments in history, placing historical events/change on a time line, describing how a significant individual influenced the UK or wider world (Henry VIII), using resources to research the 'Black Death' as an event that effected a local town or village and making connections with the modern world.
Physical Education (PE)	Tudor Dance
Music	Recognising and appreciating music from different periods in time, including the composed piece and the instruments used.

SUBJECTS THAT WE WILL TEACH IN ISOLATION THIS HALF-TERM:

Mathematics	Geometry – Properties of shape, Measures – volume and converting units.
Computing	Sketch up – 3D modelling
Physical education (PE)	Real PE Unit 6
Religious education (RE)	Islam: Approaches to life
Personal, social, health and economic (PSHE) education	Values, feelings and emotions, puberty, copyright and ownership, healthy living, change and loss and transitions.
MFL – French (KS2 only)	French history – years and famous lives

Your child will have two home learning grids for this half-term: one for the Imaginative Learning Project and one for Mathematics. They should aim to complete a minimum of 3 activities on each grid by the end of the half-term.
