TOPIC OVERVIEW

Let's explore our circulatory system!

At the start of our project, we'll explore the heart finding out the different parts and how the blood flows. We'll measure our heart rates and test how it is affected by exercise. As part of our music work, we'll use our bodies as percussion instruments and feel our pulse. We'll read personification poetry, and write poems inspired by the heart. We'll learn about how smoking affects the heart and write explanation texts related to health. In addition to learning about the heart scientifically, we will also inspect the heart from an emotional standpoint and use it in creative art activities. At the end of the ILP, we'll create PowerPoints to share what we have learned.
