TOPIC OVERVIEW

This project supports children with settling into the new rules and routines of school and encourages them to make new friends and feel confident in their class. It teaches children about being helpful, kind and thoughtful at home and at school. This project also teaches children how they are unique and special, the importance of friendship and how people in their family, school and local community are important and can help them.

ENGAGE EVENT

We will be exploring Reception and our new classrooms. When we have settled a little bit, we will be going for a walk around the school.

EXPRESS EVENT

Parents will be invited to sign up to come in and spend part of the afternoon exploring the different activities with their child.

WHAT WE WILL COVER AS PART OF THE ILP THIS HALF-TERM:

Literacy	We will be listening to lots of different stories about starting school and people who are important to us and the community. We will be beginning to learn to write our names and drawing lots of pictures of things that are important to us.
Mathematics	We will be counting actions and objects, and exploring the composition of numbers to 10.
Understanding the World	We will be talking about members of our immediate family and community. We will be learning about people who help us in school and understanding that some people are special to us.

Expressive Arts and Design	We will be developing storylines in our pretend play and making use of the role play areas. We will be creating collaboratively and sharing ideas. We will be choosing our own resources to create a variety of pictures and models. We will also be making self-portraits.
Communication and Language	We will begin to understand how to listen carefully and why listening is important. We will be engaging in story-times and beginning to describe events in some detail.
Personal, Social and Emotional Development	We will begin to build constructive and respectful relationships with our peers. We will begin to see ourselves as a valuable individual and show resilience and perseverance in the face of challenge.
Physical Development	We will explore different ways of moving such as running, hopping, skipping, etc. We will begin to use our core muscle strength to achieve a good posture whilst sitting at a table. We will also be developing the skills to manage the school day successfully.

Your child will have one home learning grids for this half-term. They should aim to complete a minimum of 2 activities on each grid by the end of the half-term.

At Hackbridge Primary School our school curriculum follows the framework for the national curriculum, supported by the use of Cornerstones materials alongside other learning and experiences, to offer a curriculum which is balanced and broadly based.

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
